What to expect in the process

Project Design Teams - From the initial meeting to completion of your project, your designer will provide one on one service to each client. Not only are you getting the attention of one qualified designer, you are benefiting from a team of ideas and opinions on what will work best in your space, creating your unique look.

On-Site Visit - Once you have decided that you are ready to move forward with your project, someone will visit your space and take measurements, photographs, etc.

Space Planning - After the on-site visit, your design team will work on design ideas to fit your space and needs.

Material Selection - Once ideas have been developed, your designer will contact you to come in and view drafted plans. You will discuss the variations of each plan and choose the best to fit your needs. Your designer will then discuss cabinet and countertop options.

Quote / Contract - After materials are selected, your design team will put together a quote. Once you approve your quote, you will then be presented with drawings and a contract to order cabinets.

Scheduling - Upon signing of the contract, your designer will discuss with you, or your general contractor, the time frame for your project. At this point specifications will be placed based upon the cabinet company lead time and our installation schedule.

Installation - Creative Kitchen and Bath provides professional installation of new cabinetry and countertops only. We do not provide any plumbing, electrical or appliance hook-ups.

Consumers should inquire about credentials of a designer and ask for references.
